Recently we invited the 2 Boards and A Passion Theatre Company in to school. They performed and conducted workshops informing children how to tackle bullying. The children then went back to their classrooms to talk about what they learnt from the performance and wrote/drew a picture/sentence in their PSHE books. 
# Parliament Trip

### **Authorisation of Holidays**

Due to changes made by the Government, all schools have been requested not to authorise holidays during term time. Therefore, parents may still request a holiday, by filling in the exceptional circumstances part of the form and this holiday will then be considered by Mrs Sarah Gilraine (Executive Headteacher).

Should the school decide not to grant a leave of absence, and parents still take their child out of school, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised, which may be subject to a Penalty Notice fine of £60 per parent per child. The fine will increase to £120 if not paid within 21 days. Failure to pay the fine in the correct timescales may lead to Court proceedings.

## <u>Standon Bowers Residential –</u> Year 6

All Year 6 children will, once again, have the opportunity to go on the residential trip. This year the trip will be on two different weeks as there are too many Year 6 children to go at the same time.
